**eligibility**

Open to all artists/media including: photography, sculpture, painting, drawing, fiber, ceramics, woodcrafts, jewelry, prints & constructions. Two dimensional work must be suitably framed & wired for hanging. Clip hangers are not acceptable. Work on paper must be under glass or Plexiglas. Three dimensional work exceeding 34" square or 100 lbs. cannot be entered without prior arrangement with the Gallery Director. If a work has specific presentation requirements this must be indicated on the entry form and there must be written documentation of the requirements attached to the work. Entries marked Not for Sale are eligible but must have a dollar value noted on the entry form (for insurance purposes) to be considered for jurying. These eligibility requirements are meant to protect your work.

**entries**

Work should be delivered to the LPCA's Fine Arts Gallery in Lake Placid from 1-5pm on September 14, 15, 16, & 17 accompanied by a \$25 non-refundable entry fee, which is the total cost to artists submitting one or two works. No more than two entries per artist. Juror will determine exhibited and non-exhibited works and awards. Make check or money order payable to "LPCA." The LPCA reserves the right to photograph works for publicity purposes.

**liability**

The Fine Arts Gallery at the LPCA will provide insurance coverage for exhibited works. The Arts Center does not assume responsibility for loss or damage to any work while on site for jurying. Work is entered at the artist's risk, although the LPCA takes every precaution to safeguard entries. Unclaimed works remaining after pickup dates become the property of the LPCA. The LPCA cannot accept submissions shipped by public carriers without special arrangements. Works shipped to the LPCA for jurying without prior arrangements for repackaging, pickup and return delivery will be refused.

**juror 1: Frank Owen**

Frank Owen is a painter who studied at Antioch College, California State University at Sacramento and the University of California at Davis, where he received his MA in 1968. Since then, he has exhibited his work in New York at the Leo Castelli Gallery and, from 1981 to the present, at the Nancy Hoffman Gallery where he showed from October to early December of 2010. He has just retired as a Professor at the University of Vermont and previously taught at the School of Visual Arts in New York. As well, he has been a visiting artist at numerous other collegiate programs. He lives and has a studio in the Adirondack Mountain village of Keene Valley, New York.

**juror 2: Bill McDowell**

Bill McDowell is an Associate Professor of Art in the Department of Art & Art History at the University of Vermont. He teaches photography, and exhibits his work widely. McDowell has a MFA in Photography from Rochester Institute of Technology.
