We will learn how to mordant wool in preparation for dyeing and spend Saturday brewing up colors for your yarn from madder root, onion skins and indigo and more to get a rainbow of color naturally.

FELTING WITH COLOR

Wool, water and soap are the basic ingredients for making felted wool. Felt has become a popular craft that is easy to make and versatile. Students will make a sheet of flat felt to be used to make felted jewelry and boxes. Students should be able to tolerate mild soap and warm water for the felting process.
