You are entitled to submit **one or two** entries of your work. The entry fee is **\$20.00**, for either one or two pieces.
Please, carefully read the eligibility requirements and guidelines for entry.

ELIGIBILITY *The Cover competition* is open to residents of Essex County or southern Franklin County (within the Adirondack Park), summer residents or artists living in the immediate vicinity of the county borders. *All other juried exhibitions* are open to any Adirondack regional artist or craftsperson.

MEDIA The Competition is open to all media including: photography, sculpture, painting, drawing, fiber, ceramics, woodcrafts, jewelry, prints and constructions.

All work must be for sale.

All work must be easily photographed and portable (for 2D, no larger than **30x30"**; framed, for 3-D **20" x 20" x 60"** and less than 40 lbs. Larger hangings that can be rolled or folded for transport within these limitations are acceptable).

Call 962-8778 if you have questions regarding dimensions.

Art or Craft work must be ready for display (i.e. framed, mounted, etc.) Subject matter DOES NOT have to have an Adirondack theme. All works are eligible except kits of any kind, work whose focal point was not created by the artist or work not ready for display.

GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY - Continued

- ✓ All artists are responsible for delivering and picking up their art work at designated times. ACNA and/or Lake Placid Center for the Arts will not be held responsible for theft of, damage to, or acts of God to art work delivered before designated date or left after pick-up date.
- ✓ Artists are responsible for all shipping charges. ACNA and/or LPCA will not be responsible for return shipping unless appropriate packaging and postage are provided by the artist.
- ✓ **Pick-up Dates: If your work is not selected for any show it can be picked up after the Opening during LPCA Gallery Hours (Tues. - Fri., 1-5 pm,) from MARCH 12th through March 31st. ALL pieces not picked up by March 31, 2010 are no longer the responsibility of ACNA or LPCA and are not insured. You will be notified of the status of your art work either by attending the exhibit or checking LPCA's website www.lakeplacidarts.org or The Arts Council's www.artsnorth.org. (NOTE: Due to the large number of pieces submitted and the high quality of all the work, selection of only one piece is not necessarily a reflection upon the work, but rather the space limitations.)**
- ✓ The Cover Art Show, the Landscape Exhibit and Public Spaces Exhibit will remain at the LPCA Fine Arts Gallery through April 9, 2010, and will then travel throughout the tri-county region from **April 15rd through December 31, 2010** (eight months). **Art work can be picked up at LPCA, Adirondack Artists Guild in Saranac Lake or the Arts Council office in Westport after January 14 2010.** Exhibits are mounted for three to six weeks at various locations including (but not limited to) Lake Placid Center for the Arts; the Depot Theatre in Westport; Hancock House in Ticonderoga; Adirondack Lakes Center for the Arts in Blue Mt. Lake; Clinton County Government Center; Goff-Nelson Memorial Library, Tupper Lake; Adirondack Center Museum, Elizabethtown; Champlain National Bank branch offices; and various galleries and restaurants.
- ✓ If for any "good" reason an artist needs a piece removed from any exhibit it must be pre-arranged with ACNA at least six weeks in advance, and may be removed only during the transition between exhibit sites.
- ✓ If a piece is sold, ACNA requests that the artist replace the piece with a similar work of like or equal value. This is not mandatory, but we would like to see you, the artist, continue to be represented in our shows. ACNA reserves the right to accept or not accept the new piece, based on standards set by the 2010 Jury.

SILENT AUCTION

With the cost of the traveling exhibits and insurance increasing, each year ACNA requests donations of one piece of work from artists or crafts persons for a Silent Auction to travel with appropriate shows. We have made over \$1,000 from 18-24 donated pieces each year for the past fourteen years. We need your support if we are to continue providing the same services in the future - securing space, mounting the exhibits, insuring the artwork both at the site and in transit, generating press releases, printing costs, repair or replacement of broken glass/frames and much more! A donation is not mandatory for entrance, acceptance or awards in the Cover Art competition or resulting shows, but is greatly appreciated.

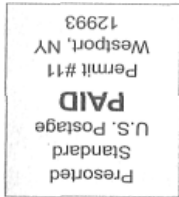
